## **ENTRY PROCEDURES**

1. Option 1: (Pre-Registration)  
Entry forms and minimum \$15.00 payment may be sent by mail up to 1 week before the event.  
**Make cheques payable to the Canadian Woodcarving Championship** and mail to :

Option 2: (On-Site Registration)  
Entry forms and payment at the CWC at the Canadian Warplane Heritage Museum.  
Entry forms will be available if required. All cheques to be made payable to: Canadian Woodcarving Championship. \$15 for the 1<sup>st</sup> piece, \$5 for each additional piece.
2. Registration:  
Entry forms, payment and carvings will be accepted at the CWC at the:  
Canadian Warplane Heritage Museum, 9280 Airport Road, Mount Hope, Ontario L0R 1W0  
From: 2:00 p.m. to 7 p.m. on Thursday and 8:30 a.m. to 10 a.m. on Friday
3. Entries can be brought in by someone other than the actual carver, provided the carver has filled in and signed the Entry Form. This "Courier" approach is encouraged. The Carver is responsible for, and must acquire, his or her **claim ticket and entry pass** from the courier. These are absolutely necessary for the claiming of a carving, Sunday at 5:00 PM.
4. Upon Registration a Claim Ticket will be issued and must be retained as a claim ticket for carvings and to claim Registration Prize if won.  
(The entry form will be used for the Registration Draw so all requested Information must be provided.)
5. Signature / Identification on the carving must be covered with tape prior to the judging.
6. Carvings will remain on display for the duration of the show and **MUST NOT** be removed until 5:00 p.m. on Sunday.
7. Shipping containers will NOT be stored at the show.
8. **Each competitor is entitled to a weekend pass.**
9. **Please provide your email address so we can email you the entry form and help reduce mailing costs.**
10. **REMEMBER:** To pick up your winnings at the CWC table on Sunday. Unclaimed prizes will be added to next year's prize pool.
